Location:

Las Alcobas Hotel sits in the heart of Polanco, Mexico City's most desirable neighborhood. Intersected by Avenida Presidente Masaryk, the "Rodeo Drive of Mexico City," Polanco is green with parks and flowering trees, dotted with private homes and leading-brand boutiques, corporate offices, art galleries and lively with the city's finest restaurants and cafes, with beckoning interiors and sidewalk tables.

Ownership:

Las Alcobas is an owner-operated, independent hotel and affiliated with Marriott's prestigious Luxury Collection. It is the only LC member in Mexico City.

Design/Architecture:

ture: Las Alcobas was designed by Yabu Pushelberg (the Toronto/New York-based interior-design firm behind the aesthetic of selected Louis Vuitton, Four Seasons Hotels, Edition and Rosewood Hotels). Yabu Pushelberg refurbished the guest rooms and spa at Las Alcobas in 2020.

Lobby:

Original artwork and ironwork, earth-toned furnishings, and a softly splashing fountain give the lobby a mid-century feel fused with a modern, spa-like serenity. Rising from its midst, a spiral stairway curls upwards like a ribbon of polished rosewood. Every surface is tasteful and textured, every detail custom made.

Accommodations:

s: 35 guestrooms, including 3 penthouse suites (the only suites in Mexico City to feature open terraces) and a two-bedroom suite, are spread out through the seven-story building. In size, the rooms range from 400 to 1,600 square feet.

All rooms feature:

- Custom-made rosewood furniture
- Cutting-edge technology including 55-inch flat-screen televisions, air-filtration systems, automated central controls (drapes, sheers, lighting, AC, service and DND) that allow guests to tailor their own ambiance and privacy.
- Spa-inspired, all-marble bathrooms equipped with I tubs, a "menu" of handmade soaps, eight-jet showers, enclosed WC with integrated bidets, mirror defoggers, Bulgari bath amenities, plush terry robes.



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- Hypoallergenic goose-down pillows and comforters, with luxurious bed sheets from Rivolta Carmignani, the Milanese manufacturer of the world's finest linens and terry
- Fully stocked minibar with complimentary non-alcoholic drinks and snacks
- Rosewood dressing room walk-through area with fold-out three-way mirrors and custom closets
- Custom leather wall panels with inlaid artistic stitching
- Witting areas with custom desks with multiple electrical outlets
- All suites have spacious terraces with unobstructed views of Mexico City.
- Presidential Suite has a wrap-around terrace and indoor/outdoor fireplace
- Twice-daily housekeeping service

Anatol Restaurant:

An elegant yet casual 60-seat restaurant serving breakfast (including Mexican specialties), lunch and dinner (international farm-to-table dishes, plus a creative menu of house cocktails). The restaurant features outdoor dining on its spacious terrace.

Aurora Spa:

An intimate spa offering the latest massage therapies and skin revitalization techniques, as well as indigenous ingredients and treatments. Signature services include the popular Aztec and Mayan Healing Rituals. Salon services available upon request at a nearby facility.

Fitness Center:

Cardio and weight training equipment. Yoga, fitness instructors, and private training available upon request.

- Aci: welcome refreshment delivered to room upon check in ("Aci" means "to arrive" in Nahuatl, the ancient language of Mexico City)
- "Stay-Strategy" meeting with concierge on day of arrival.
- Anfitrion: a distinctive blend of butler and concierge.
- *Despertar*: wake up service with choice of beverage.
- Mi Segunda Casa: returning guests are encouraged to see Las Alcobas as a second home, storing personal belongings in private hotel wardrobe. Includes cleaning, pressing, laundering, repairing, and replenishment of favorite toiletries.
- Espumas: guests select two handmade soaps from an extensive selection. Soaps reflect ancient Mexican traditions and soothing bath rituals.
- 24-hour room service
- valet service and/or garage with private entrance; helipad available nearby
